

How to be UNAFRAID in a Changing World...Let's face it. Our world has changed overnight. For some, this has brought a lot of uncertainty and worries. Some are struggling with fear & anxiety and wondering how they can adjust to this constantly changing situation.

Adam Hamilton has offered an informed and inspiriting message full of practical solutions and hope in a five-week study entitled *UNAFRAID*. This study can be video streamed online. We are encouraging people to watch the video stream anytime during the week and then gather together by way of zoom on Sunday mornings beginning on April 26 at 10:00 AM. Kurt Streicher and Pat Thornton will co-facilitate these sessions.

For those without access to video streaming or for those who would like to read the book, call the church office to pick up a book or request that a copy be delivered to you. We have a few DVD's that we can loan if you would like to watch that from home. (Sessions run from 15-18 minutes)

Please give serious thought to participating in this study as it offers an honest assessment about the danger of nurturing fears and the power of facing them down. It draws on Scripture and science as it offers a faith-filled guide to reclaiming our minds and our lives in this ever-changing world, and, by doing so, helps us find ways to lead lives of hope and courage. - 1. Call the church office. (563-355-5218).

Go to the bottom of the page and click on "Congregational Care". You will be taken to a page that gives you 3 options:

Visiting Form: to fill out if you have offered care to someone.

Need Assistance?: if you would like to request help for something.

Can you help?: if you are willing to help someone else who has a need.
