Our August sermon series has been *Go Fish*! The theme comes from Jesus' invitation to his first disciples to "Follow me and I will make you fish for people" (Matthew 4:19 and Mark 1:17). Jesus' invitation to fish for people doesn't mean trying to force people to do something against their will. It means walking with other people, being a friend, and receiving the blessing of a relationship with another person that is a reflection of our relationship with God. We have a message to share that **Jesus is the bridge** to God and other people.

We are in the midst of a shift in our way of thinking from "how do we get other people into our church building" to "how do we get our people out to be with other people?" While we can always do that individually, we also want to work on this together as a church. We are developing the concept of Neighborhood Captains. The idea is that this would be a person who is willing, ready and prepared to connect with people in their area. This would include both current church members and also the neighbors that may not have a church home. In the coming weeks we'll be developing descriptions of how a Neighborhood Captain could serve and then be asking for people to give it a try. There will be support and supervision along the way.

I hope you'll follow Jesus' invitation to *Go Fish*, on your own and together as the Asbury Church as we go out and fish for people. Pastor Tom
