# Worship Changes! Beginning on Sunday, November 29, the Online Worship Start Time Will Change from 10:00 AM to <u>10:30 AM</u>

#### Proposed In-Person "Studio Audience" for the 10:30 AM Worship Service

If things go well, the current plan is that up to 65 people will be allowed in the sanctuary during the 10:30am livestreamed worship service beginning on Sunday, November 29. The 8:00 AM in person worship will not change.

In Order to Be Safe... All worship services in the building will require masks and social distancing. We can accommodate a maximum of 65 people in the sanctuary. So far that hasn't been an issue at the 8:00 worship. If it becomes a problem at either worship, we will transition to some kind of pre-registration. Our Garden Ministry continues to be blessed with a harvest of about 34,500 lbs. of fresh vegetables that were distributed to 19 organizations that include food pantries, meal sites, home shelters, and senior living apartment complexes. In addition, some produce was distributed to individual families. Since its beginning in the spring of 2002, over 600,000 lbs. of fresh vegetables have been distributed.
