

CHANGES ARE COMING TO ASBURY'S LIBRARY

Asbury is blessed to have a large comprehensive library. However, the time has come to "right-size" it, so our library's resources and our building will be better used. In a digital age, information access has moved out of only a room to a worldwide resource. Our adult and children's libraries now fill two rooms, neither of which has been well-used in recent years. To conduct this right-sizing project, a task force has been formed, comprised of the Adult Ministries Team, past library committee members, and staff.

The plan is to significantly reduce and reorganize both libraries, making them more useable and creating much-needed space for other uses. The remaining adult library books and materials will probably stay in part of their current room. The children's library will vacate its current room and will be moved downstairs to the TreeHouse children's area. The task force has begun to identify books and materials which are of low importance to Asbury's ministry and which can be removed. In the future, the removed items will be offered to the congregation and to others, especially as pandemic restrictions are relaxed.

Physical books and materials will continue to be important at Asbury. We will retain and add those which are relevant to our members and our ministry. This will be an ongoing project, and the input and involvement of interested people will be welcomed. More information will be available on Asbury's website, and updates will appear in future Good News newsletters.
