# Library Update: Free Books Available Through April



A team of staff and volunteers is moving forward with rightsizing and updating Asbury's library— to make it more useful, to get books into the hands of more people, and to use our building more efficiently. A survey was done in February, with 63 responses, indicating that few people have used our library in recent years. With internet technology and with well-equipped public libraries, traditional church libraries are giving way to smaller reading and resource centers.

The team has sorted thousands of books and materials in the adult and children's libraries and has placed a large number of them in Upper Fellowship Hall, FREE TO ANYONE through April 30th. People may come to the church during office hours (8:00AM-12:00 noon, Monday-Friday) and during Sunday morning worship and may take as many books as they wish, with no sign-outs required. Books are displayed in marked categories, to simplify browsing. Many important library books and materials will be KEPT and reorganized, such as Bible reference, John Wesley, United Methodism, denominational structure, Christian living, and Asbury's history.

Donations of books to our library will no longer be normally accepted, except those used for all-church or small group studies. If someone has a book which they believe is important to have in our library, they should contact Linda Manning, our Adult Ministries Director. Carrie Meumann, Director of Children and Youth Ministries, will oversee the books and materials for children and youth. Asbury will continue to purchase and provide Sunday School materials, small group study books and DVDs.
