## A New Organizational Plan is Proposed for the Future

The Charge Conference on November 16 will consider a Revised Organizational Structure designed to accomplish 3 objectives:

- Increase Engagement
- Be More Action-Oriented
- Make Efficient Use of Time

A special task force led by Steve Sorensen has been meeting all year to propose revised organizational structure changes. They have grouped all of our ministries and activities into five Areas of Ministry:

- Worship
- Discipleship
- Welcome & Care
- Missions
- Support/Administration



### Two New Concepts Include:

- 1. Electing a Team Leader for each of the five areas. These Team Leaders would serve as "At Large" Members of the Church Council and would also support and coordinate the various aspects of ministry in their area.
- 2. Church Council would only meet quarterly (4 times per year), and the area Team Leaders would meet quarterly as well, with the purpose of strategizing changes in direction. The individual committees & teams would also meet quarterly. The benefit would be that the number of committee meetings would be reduced and there would be specific time devoted to maintaining our current ministries, as well as strategizing for new ministries and initiatives. If the proposal goes forward, we'll try it out in the coming year! Pastor Tom
