<u>Ready for Departures</u>....When we set the sermon series theme of "*Ready for Departures*" I had in mind getting ready for the ways our lives can change. Sometimes by our choice and other times not by our choice but due to things beyond our control. During Lent we can choose to leave our old ways behind in order to become more like Jesus.

But we are also now dealing with factors that are beyond our control that require us to travel to a new place. One is the Russian invasion and war in Ukraine. The way the world was is now behind us and we must all adapt to a new reality. (See the next page for information on how to support the church in Ukraine.)

Another factor is that the General Conference of our United Methodist Church has been delayed again and will not meet until it's normal time of 2024. It has also been announced that a new denomination for churches wishing to depart from the United Methodist Church will begin this May.

These are just two of the larger factors beyond our control that will require us to adapt to a new reality. But the most important thing that will enable us to adapt is our relationship with Jesus and the good news that God is with us on this journey. We will still seek God's light in this new reality and find the hope to persevere. And we will still seek ways to share God's love and do God's will along the way to a new destination. In worship we'll continue to look at how this may not be the departure we expected, but it is still one for which we must be ready. And with God's help, we will be ready. Pastor Tom

March 27 is UMCOR Celebration Sunday



Do you know that while you sleep, your brain is working to consolidate your memories and learning? It is moving memories from short term to long-term memory. That activity is only one of the many things occurring while you sleep. Hormone production is happening. Your heart is resting and renewing itself. Your immune system is scanning for diseases.

The guality and guantity of sleep effects many aspects of wellness—your weight, blood pressure, heart health, fitness, metabolism, development of diabetes, and depression.
