Fall 2022 Small Group Opportunities for Adults





THE LORD'S PRAYER

If you were asked to name a prayer that most people might know, how would you respond? The "Now I lay me down to sleep", the "Be present at our table Lord", or would it be the Lord's Prayer—"Our Father, who art in Heaven"?

If you said, The Lord's Prayer, do you really know the Lord's Prayer, or have you simply memorized it and now say it by rote? Have you taught this prayer to someone—your children, grandchildren, or a friend? If so, have you discussed it's meaning or simply helped someone "learn it"?

Our Fall Sunday Sermon Study Series is a study using Adam Hamilton's book, THE LORD'S PRAYER. This six-week study brings the Lord's Prayer into sharp focus. New meaning and understanding is brought to this well-known prayer as one listens to the video portion where Hamilton explores and explains the meaning of each phrase. With the new light and depth shared, it is easy to understand why the Lord's Prayer is so very important and one of the foundations of the Christian faith experience.

One of the comments regarding this study states: "Hamilton wakes us from the slumber of monotony. He shakes up our understanding of familiar passages, shifts our perspective, and invites us to experience the Lord's Prayer as more than a model of how to pray. It is a MODEL OF HOW TO LIVE!" The goal is clear: Hamilton wants our lives to become a prayer.

Hamilton feels that the Lord's Prayer is The Most Important Prayer of All and has written a children's book with the same title. It is available to the children in our congregation, but you are also encouraged to take one for your grandchildren or other kids in your life and share with them. Both the adult and children's book are available without cost, but donations are always appreciated.

Hopefully, as we participate in this Fall Sunday Sermon Study Series, we will never be able to recite the Lord's Prayer casually or mindlessly again. Instead, a greater sense of awe, humility, reverence, and purpose of call to the Christian life will accompany us each time we pray the most important prayer of all—The Lord's Prayer.
