# A Message from Your Parish Nurse Team **3 Tips to Curb Holiday Eating Habits**



The holidays are packed with fun and festivities that can sabotage healthy eating. While we're not suggesting that you shouldn't enjoy the holiday treats, here are some suggestions to use when choosing from ALL that is on display!

- Stick to Year-Round Habits of Health Holidays last only a few days; don't make them go all month. Stick with your regular routines for health the best you can. If you do overeat, get right back to your regular habits of health. Have selfcompassion.
- Budget Wisely Don't eat everything at feasts and parties. Be choosy and eat just a few favorites. Also, take a moment to savor the food. The first few bites are the best when your taste buds are the most sensitive.
- Hold Plate in Dominant Hand Try holding your plate while at the event in your dominant hand and use your non-dominant hand to pick up food (or use your fork). This slows your eating down and you end up eating less.
- BONUS TIP: Don't Go on an Empty Stomach Before going out the door to a dinner or party, eat something like an apple and a tablespoon or two of nuts. This way you don't arrive hungry and overeat.
