Possible Trip to the Holy Lands?

When the pastor of my youth and young adult years retired, he said that the one thing he would have done differently in his ministry was to have traveled to the Holy Lands earlier in his career rather than later. His story inspired me to be part of a tour group to Israel hosted in 1997 by Iowa Bishop Charles Wesley Jordan and organized by Educational Opportunities. I can say that reading and understanding the Bible has always been more meaningful since my trip so many years ago.

During this season of Lent we are using the resource, "Seven-Mile Miracle" as our guide. Each of the weekly lessons in the videos of the resource is filmed on location at various sights in the Holy Lands. They have

brought back powerful memories and have got me wondering if Asbury members might be interested in a group trip to the Holy Lands. Other United Methodist congregations in our area are planning a trip to Israel in 2024. I have spoken with those pastors about the possibility of doing something together.

The amazing story of Jesus is not only that it happened in a specific place 2,000 years ago, but that it is also still happening in our lives where we live today. Quarterly Church Council will Include a Special Charge Conference

Everyone is invited to attend Church Council at 6:30 pm, Monday, March 20 in the Fellowship Hall or on Zoom. We will review our current status as a church and look ahead to the coming months.

As part of the evening, we will also conduct a Special Charge Conference for the purpose of making a formal decision regarding the open Associate Pastor appointment at Asbury. A Charge Conference is required to make certain decisions by a congregation including the determination of pastoral staff needs. In the summer of 2021, our Associate Pastor position was left unfilled while we attempted a different staffing configuration. The rationale was that the funds used to support one full-time ordained associate pastor with benefits could be reallocated to hire various part-time positions with specialized responsibilities. We have found this to be a workable alternative. The Staff Parish Relations Committee and the Leadership Team have recommended that we officially discontinue the appointment since it does not look like we will seek to fill it in the foreseeable future. Only Council members will be authorized to vote, but anyone is welcome to attend. If you would like the Council meeting Zoom link, please call the church office.



Asbury has been preparing and serving a meal once a month to those in need for many years. Currently, we are serving approximately 60 meals each month. In an effort to give more Asburians an opportunity to serve and participate in this important outreach mission, we are

changing Asbury's process which has been in place since Covid times.

Effective with our May 3rd Meal Prep and Serve, we will be providing and serving a routine and fairly easy dinner menu at Zion. In March and April, we are asking Asbury members and families to sign-up to be on a team of 5 or 6 people that will be assigned no more than 2 months a year to prep the food, transport and serve the Wednesday night meal.
