NEW BUILDING ENTRANCE PROCEDURES

During office hours when staff is present, people can enter the building using the Office Entrance. At all other times, please use the Main Entrance. The Main Entrance doors can now be unlocked using any church phone. Pressing the button labeled "Main Entrance Door Unlock" will unlock the door for about 5 seconds.

A new door camera can be viewed on the displays throughout the building. People inside can speak to people at the door by pressing the blue microphone button on the display. Blue waves radiating out from the button indicate that the microphone is on and people at the door can hear people speaking to the display. The doorbell only rings in the office, so we urge group leaders to watch the display for people to arrive and to also share your cell phone number with those in your group as another tool to let you know they are at the door.

May is National Mental Health Awareness Month

When a loved one is affected by depression, it can be difficult to understand what is happening or what you can do to help. Keep in mind that depression can have symptoms such as: feelings of sadness, emptiness or hopelessness; loss of intertest or pleasure in most all normal activities; insomnia; lack of energy; feelings of worthlessness or guilt; changes in appetite; or trouble thinking, concentrating or making decisions.

You can assist your loved one in the healing process by considering these ideas:

- Encourage sticking with treatment if that has begun.
- Be willing to listen—when desired.
- Give positive reinforcement.
- Offer assistance with certain tasks they are having trouble completing.
- Help establish a routine.
- Locate helpful local organizations.
- Make plans together.
- Be patient.

Donations toward these two initiatives help us be stewards of God's creation by using resources wisely through recycling and taking an action that helps protect God's creation from climate change. Terracycle is an eco-ministry located at Trinity Lutheran Church in Moline. They collect, sort and send items to recycling centers, to be made into new products. Terracycle relies on financial donations for the purchase of Zero-Waste boxes and shipping costs to keep this program available here in the Quad Cities.

EARTHDAY.ORG's Canopy Project improves our shared environment by planting trees across the globe. They work with global partners to reforest areas in dire need of rehabilitation. This reforestation helps many disadvantaged communities, increases habitat for species, and combats climate change.
