QUESTIONS JESUS ASKED by Magrey deVega

Have there been times in your life that you have asked God questions and really wanted answers? Some of our questions may have come in the midst of hardships and grief, while others such as "Lord, why did you make mosquitoes?" are more "light-hearted".

However, have you ever thought about what questions Jesus might ask you? How would you answer? In his latest book, QUESTIONS JESUS ASKED, Magrey deVega explores six of the most provocative questions Jesus posed to others. Jesus didn't give answers. He asked questions and often answered a question by asking the person another question. There are over 300 questions that Jesus asked recorded in the scriptures!

Answers to questions can inform, interpret, or be evaluative. Jesus askes the deepest questions as He doesn't just seek "the right answer" but wants you to know what difference that answer makes in your life.

deVega points out that time plays a big factor in how we view God. While God doesn't change, our relationship to Him does, and it is up to us to keep our relationship current.

deVega talks about fear and the fact that fear is universal. He explains that fear is tied up with grief (what we've lost or what we might lose in the future). The solution according to deVega is gratitude! deVega also talks about free-will and forgiveness in conflict. He helps us see how the following six questions bring a fuller appreciation of the wisdom, power, and presence of God in our lives as we experience spiritual growth (and move along the Discipleship Pathway).

So, what are these six questions that Jesus asked?


1-Who Do You Say That I AM? 2-Why Are You Terrified? 3-Why Are You Anxious? 4-What Do You Live For? 5-Whom Will You Love? 6-What Are You Looking For?
