A long-held tradition at Asbury is to dedicate a special Christmas Offering to support our outreach mission work. This year's Christmas Offering will be split evenly between two important outreach missions:

Monthly "Backpack" outreach at neighboring **Mark Twain Elementary School**, and **Churches United of the Quad City Area** to support their mission work.

Mark Twain Elementary School Backpack Ministry

Prior to the pandemic, Asbury provided snack backpacks to students of families in need at Jefferson and Mark Twain schools. The pandemic put an abrupt end to this mission activity. We are excited that Asbury is once again partnering with Mark Twain to provide backpacks filled with nutritious snacks for designated elementary students. We purchased snack items, filled and delivered backpacks for 24 students in November and will continue this monthly mission through the end of the school year in May. The Christmas offering will help Asbury to subsidize the purchase of these snack items.

Churches United of the Quad City Area

Asbury is a proud and long-time member of Churches United of the Quad Cities, an ecumenical coalition of area Churches organized to feed the hungry, provide transitional housing (Winnie's Place) for women and children who are victims of domestic violence and human trafficking, and offer emergency crisis assistance. Asbury supports Churches United ministries work through volunteering at the Bettendorf Food Pantry and providing a monthly meal at the Zion Lutheran meal site. This Christmas offering is yet one other way Asburians can "do God's will" through our financial support for Churches United's Quad City wide ministries.

Other December Outreach Opportunities & Events


