... is Now.



Bits and Pieces from Your Parish Nurse Team



Over the course of the next few newsletters, we will remind everyone of the services provided by our Parish Nurse program. We participate in many health-related activities. We are available to be a referral and advocacy liaison helping to coordinate a plan of care with hospitals and care centers and/or guide persons in using community resources. We make visits to homes, hospitals and care centers. We assist families in times of crisis. We are on call to stay with individuals during surgery if family is not available. We incorporate spiritual values into health education and communicate issues of concern to the pastor. We listen and keep information confidential unless we are asked to share it.

We also provide spiritual and emotional support. We serve on the Prayer Team by following up personally on requests. We provide quarterly anointing services (and when individually requested). We lead Grief Share groups. We take communion into homes. We send sympathy cards. Physical support is provided through four blood drives each year, monthly foot clinics and training in Hands Only CPR and use of the AED. We have monies available to assist those in need of food, shelter and travel aide.
