The mission of this agency is connecting individuals and caregivers to aging and disability resources in the community. It is the organization for assisting older lowans & adults with disabilities and their caregivers to help identify and access the services and resources needed to remain independent and self-sufficient. This is accomplished in the following ways:

- 1. Inform, Referral and Assistance connection to community networks and resources.
- 2. Care Coordination/Options Counseling short-term individual planning and implementation of long-term support.
- 3. Family Caregiver Program support for those who provide care for adults who are over the age of 60.
 4. lowa Return to Community facilitates the transition back to home/community after hospital stay or rehabilitation.
- 5. Senior Health Insurance Program connects knowledgeable volunteers with individuals to provide guidance for Medicare and other health insurance programs.
