M Bits and Pieces from Your Parish Nurse Team APRIL IS NATIONAL DONATE LIFE MONTH



This month features local and national activities to educate and encourage Americans to register as donors and consider a living donation, as well as to celebrate those who have saved and healed lives through the gift of donation upon their death. Here are some facts to know:

- •More than 100,000 people are waiting for lifesaving organ transplants.
- •More than 46,000 organ transplants from 23,000 donors brought new life to patients and their families in 2023.
- •More than 79,000 corneal transplants helped to restore sight in 2022.
- •More than 2.5 million tissue transplants heal lives each year.
- •More than 170 million people are registered organ, eye and tissue donors.

One Organ, Eye and Tissue Donor saves up to 8 lives, restores sight to 2 people, and heals the lives of more than 75 people. 86% of patients waiting need a kidney. Living donors can provide a kidney or a portion of their liver to a waiting patient. 10% of patients waiting need a liver.
