Many of us have experienced a day that changed our lives. It may have been a happy time - a graduation, marriage, the birth of a baby, or it may have been a sad time - some type of disaster or the death of a loved one. As we look back on that day that changed our life, we may discover that it also affected others.

Regardless of what we experienced, it can't begin to compare with what Jesus went through during the 24 Hours that He willingly endured so that we might know that He understands and is with us throughout our lives regardless of what events we encounter. His sacrifice offered salvation or eternal life with Him! Those 24 Hours changed the lives of all people from that time forward and still affects our lives today!

Our Sunday Sermon Study Series for Lent is **24 HOURS THAT CHANGED THE WORLD** by Adam Hamilton. The aim of 24 HOURS THAT CHANGED THE WORLD is to help one better understand the events that occurred during the last twenty-four hours of Jesus' life. It is truly amazing that Jesus managed to get to the cross, let alone endure the cross, and by so doing, offer each of us the opportunity to be with Him.

No single event in human history has received more attention than the suffering and crucifixion of Jesus of Nazareth. Hamilton helps one experience and understand the significance of Jesus' suffering and death like never before. He retraces the day that changed human history in his usual straightforward, yet easy, conversational style that speaks to both long-time Christians and those who are simply curious about the story of Christ's crucifixion.

The first six sessions cover the events leading to Christ's crucifixion and discuss what it would have been like to be at the foot of the cross. Have you ever thought about what might have gone on in the mind of the Roman centurion? What about how Mary must have felt, and what about the disciples, especially John and Peter?

The seventh session, the final one which is after Easter, focuses on Jesus' victory over death and what happened prior to his appearance to the disciples. We will consider the incredible promise of Easter; the hope of life after death, and examine the theories of Atonement and what it might mean for our lives.

Some of you may remember this study when we did it in 2012. It is one that had a profound effect on some and the Adult Ministry Team decided that it would be prudent to repeat this study. Hamilton has expanded the book to include devotions for each chapter and travel notes from his trip to the Holy Lands. The first sermon will be on Sunday, March 9, 2025 (following Ash Wednesday). We encourage everyone to pick up the book and get involved with an Adult Small Group that will watch the video which accompanies this study. Discussion, fellowship, and support are offered as well!
